



## Sylva Polish

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

If the floor needs to be revitalised then Junckers Sylva Polish will help to hide minor scratches.

Polish can be used as a cleaning product, but also revives a dull looking surface and protects the floor.

Floors treated with polish will require sanding back to bare wood, if the floor at a later point needs re-lacquering.

**Product:**

Nonionic tenside, cleaning agent with a silk matt appearance

**Package sizes:**

1 liter. & 5 liter.

## TECHNICAL DATA

**Coverage:** Approx. 80 - 100 m<sup>2</sup> per litre.

**PH Value:**

Concentrate: Approx. 8.6

Diluted: 8.3

**Before application:** Shake/stir well before use.

**Application tools:**

Well wrung out cloth, or damp mop.

**Substrate temperature:** Minimum 5° C.

**Dilution:** 100 ml. to 10 litre of water

**Cleaning of tools:** Clean water

**Storage:** Lasts for 2 years if unopened and stored at 20°C. Not to be exposed to temperatures below 0°C.

## DIRECTION FOR USE

Always use as little water as possible for cleaning.

Dilute according to recommendation and clean the floor with a well wrung out mop or cloth.

Remove excess water immediately so as to avoid water damage.

On high traffic floors Sylva Polish can be used undiluted.

Areas treated with Sylva Polish should not be buffed as this will make the floor slippery.
